open Of textures full of small openings or gaps.

(especially of something undesirable) not controlled or restrained.

unchecked Prices rose unchecked hitting the poor worst of all.

unconstrained Not restricted or limited.

The dog was **unconstrained**.

unhampered Not slowed or blocked or interfered with.

Unhampered dissemination of news.



unhindered Not hindered or obstructed.

An exhilarating walk **unhindered** by walls and fences.

Expressing one's feelings or thoughts unselfconsciously and without

uninhibited restraint.

Fits of **uninhibited** laughter.

unlimited Without reservation or exception.

Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not **unlimited**.

unrestricted Free of restrictions on conduct.

Unrestricted verbs are usually stronger than those qualified by adverbs.

Not confined or limited.

untrammelled A mind untrammelled by convention.
