### Synonyms of "Unimpeded" as an adjective (11 Words)

<b><a href="#">clear</a></b>	Clear and distinct to the senses easily perceptible. <i>A <b>clear</b> case of poisoning.</i>
<b>free</b>	(of power or energy) disengaged or available. <i>He pulled his arm <b>free</b> and ran.</i>
<b>open</b>	Of textures full of small openings or gaps. <i>Both sides played fast <b>open</b> rugby to produce a high scoring game.</i>
<b><a href="#">unchecked</a></b>	(especially of something undesirable) not controlled or restrained. <i>Prices rose <b>unchecked</b> hitting the poor worst of all.</i>
<b>unconstrained</b>	Not restricted or limited. <i>The dog was <b>unconstrained</b>.</i>
<b>unhampered</b>	Not slowed or blocked or interfered with. <i><b>Unhampered</b> dissemination of news.</i>

<b>unhindered</b>	Not hindered or obstructed. <i>An exhilarating walk <b>unhindered</b> by walls and fences.</i>
<b><u>uninhibited</u></b>	Expressing one's feelings or thoughts unselfconsciously and without restraint. <i>Fits of <b>uninhibited</b> laughter.</i>
<b>unlimited</b>	Without reservation or exception. <i>Offshore reserves of gas and oil are not <b>unlimited</b>.</i>
<b>unrestricted</b>	Free of restrictions on conduct. <i><b>Unrestricted</b> verbs are usually stronger than those qualified by adverbs.</i>
<b>untrammelled</b>	Not confined or limited. <i>A mind <b>untrammelled</b> by convention.</i>

### **Usage Examples of "Unimpeded" as an adjective**

- *An unimpeded view across the headland.*
- *An unimpeded sweep of meadows and hills afforded a peaceful setting.*
- *A time of unimpeded growth.*
