<u>unaffected</u>	Unaware of or indifferent to. The walks are suitable only for people who are <b>unaffected</b> by vertigo.
undismayed	Unshaken in purpose. <b>Undismayed</b> my mother sent me to a first class crammer for two terms.
unperturbed	Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension. Kenneth seems <b>unperturbed</b> by the news.
unruffled	Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension- Anthony Trollope. Robbie seemed <b>unruffled</b> by her words.
unstirred	Not agitated by stirring. Waters that are ice covered remain <b>unstirred</b> by wind.
<u>untouched</u>	Not influenced or affected. Annabel pushed aside her <b>untouched</b> plate.
untroubled	Free from turmoil or worries. <i>Untroubled</i> times.



#### **unworried** Not anxious or uneasy. *Foreign investors are largely* **unworried** by the government s fall.



### Usage Examples of "Unimpressed" as an adjective

- Trying to appear unimpressed.
- Consumers are largely unimpressed by the products.
- *He was unimpressed with the news.*
