unaffected Unaware of or indifferent to.

undismayed Unshaken in purpose.

Smayed Undismayed my mother sent me to a first class crammer for two terms.

unperturbed Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension.

Kenneth seems **unperturbed** by the news.

unruffled Free from emotional agitation or nervous tension- Anthony Trollope.

Robbie seemed **unruffled** by her words.

unstirred Not agitated by stirring.

Waters that are ice covered remain unstirred by wind.

untouched Not influenced or affected.

Annabel pushed aside her **untouched** plate.

untroubled Free from turmoil or worries.

Untroubled times.
