Not having a good education. uneducated

The workforce remains largely **uneducated** and unskilled.

Not having or showing an enlightened outlook. unenlightened

**Unenlightened** thinking.

Not well informed or educated. unknowledgeable

Services staffed by **unknowledgeable** people.

(of a person) not well educated.

unlearned He appealed to an **unlearned** audience as well as to sympathetic

scholars.



**unread** (of a book or document) not read.

He seems to have been wholly **unread** in political theory.

untaught Not acquired by teaching; natural or spontaneous.

**Untaught** people whose verbal skills are grossly deficient.
