Uninformed as an Adjective

Definitions of "Uninformed" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “uninformed” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not having or showing awareness or understanding of the facts.*
- *Not informed; lacking in knowledge or information.*



Synonyms of "Uninformed" as an adjective (7 Words)

ignorant	Uneducated in general; lacking knowledge or sophistication. <i>I was largely ignorant of the effects of radiotherapy.</i>
uneducated	Not having a good education. <i>The workforce remains largely uneducated and unskilled.</i>
unenlightened	Not having or showing an enlightened outlook. <i>Unenlightened thinking.</i>
unknowledgeable	Not well informed or educated. <i>Services staffed by unknowledgeable people.</i>
unlearned	(of a person) not well educated. <i>He appealed to an unlearned audience as well as to sympathetic scholars.</i>

unread

(of a book or document) not read.

*He seems to have been wholly **unread** in political theory.*

untaught

Not acquired by teaching; natural or spontaneous.

***Untaught** people whose verbal skills are grossly deficient.*



Usage Examples of "Uninformed" as an adjective
