Definitions of "Uninhabited" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “uninhabited” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not having inhabitants; not lived in.*
- *(of a place) without inhabitants.*



Synonyms of "Uninhabited" as an adjective (10 Words)

empty	Emptied of emotion. <i>Their promises were empty words.</i>
free	Costing nothing. <i>Free enterprise.</i>
unfilled	Of purchase orders that have not been filled. <i>There are a number of unfilled posts in this area of nursing.</i>
unfrequented	(of a place) visited only rarely. <i>A trail leading to an unfrequented lake.</i>
unoccupied	Not held or filled or in use. <i>An unoccupied telephone booth.</i>
unpeopled	Empty of people. <i>The eerily unpeopled streets.</i>
unpopulated	(of a place) having no inhabitants. <i>Vast unpopulated plains.</i>

- unsettled** Subject to change.
*An **unsettled** issue.*
- untenanted** (of property) not occupied by a tenant or tenants.
*Very little unclaimed and **untenanted** land.*
- vacant** (of a position or employment) not filled.
*40 per cent of the offices are still **vacant**.*



Usage Examples of "Uninhabited" as an adjective

- *Gaping doors of uninhabited houses.*
- *An uninhabited island.*
- *Small uninhabited islands.*
