- *Not having inhabitants; not lived in.*
- *(of a place) without inhabitants.*



## Synonyms of "Uninhabited" as an adjective (10 Words)

<b>empty</b>	Emptied of emotion. <i>Their promises were <b>empty</b> words.</i>
<b>free</b>	Costing nothing. <i><b>Free</b> enterprise.</i>
<b>unfilled</b>	Of purchase orders that have not been filled. <i>There are a number of <b>unfilled</b> posts in this area of nursing.</i>
<b>unfrequented</b>	(of a place) visited only rarely. <i>A trail leading to an <b>unfrequented</b> lake.</i>
<b>unoccupied</b>	Not held or filled or in use. <i>An <b>unoccupied</b> telephone booth.</i>
<b>unpeopled</b>	Empty of people. <i>The eerily <b>unpeopled</b> streets.</i>
<b>unpopulated</b>	(of a place) having no inhabitants. <i>Vast <b>unpopulated</b> plains.</i>



- unsettled** Subject to change.  
*An **unsettled** issue.*
- untenanted** (of property) not occupied by a tenant or tenants.  
*Very little unclaimed and **untenanted** land.*
- vacant** (of a position or employment) not filled.  
*40 per cent of the offices are still **vacant**.*



## Usage Examples of "Uninhabited" as an adjective

- *Gaping doors of uninhabited houses.*
- *An uninhabited island.*
- *Small uninhabited islands.*
