unfilled Of purchase orders that have not been filled.

unfrequented (of a place) visited only rarely.

A trail leading to an unfrequented lake.

unoccupied Not held or filled or in use.

An **unoccupied** telephone booth.

unpeopled Empty of people.

The eerily **unpeopled** streets.

unpopulated (of a place) having no inhabitants.

Vast **unpopulated** plains.



unsettled Subject to change.

An **unsettled** issue.

untenanted (of property) not occupied by a tenant or tenants.

Very little unclaimed and untenanted land.

vacant (of a position or employment) not filled.
40 per cent of the offices are still vacant.
