brainless	Not using intelligence. A brainless bimbo.
dense	Hard to pass through because of dense growth. Dense vegetation.
empty-headed	Lacking seriousness; given to frivolity.
foolish	Lacking good sense or judgement; unwise. He was foolish enough to confide in her.
half-witted	Retarded in intellectual development.
idiotic	Incongruous;inviting ridicule. An idiotic idea.

ignorant	Unaware because of a lack of relevant information or knowledge. <i>He was told constantly that he was ignorant and stupid.</i>
imbecile	Having a mental age of three to seven years. <i>Try not to make imbecile remarks.</i>
imbecilic	Having a mental age of three to seven years.
mindless	Not mindful or attentive- G.B.Shaw. <i>Mindless of the fact she was in her nightie she rushed to the door.</i>
moronic	Having a mental age of between eight and twelve years. <i>Television s latest moronic soap opera.</i>
obtuse	Lacking in insight or discernment- Jasper Griffin. <i>Some of the lyrics are a bit obtuse.</i>
simple-minded	Lacking mental capacity and subtlety.
slow	Of a sports field or ground likely to make the ball bounce or run slowly or to prevent competitors from travelling fast. <i>The slow lane.</i>
vacuous	Void of expression. <i>Vacuous slogans.</i>
vapid	Offering nothing that is stimulating or challenging; bland. <i>Vapid beer.</i>
witless	(of especially persons) lacking sense or understanding or judgment. <i>I was scared witless.</i>

Usage Examples of "Unintelligent" as an adjective
