## Unintentionally as an Adverb

### Definitions of "Unintentionally" as an adverb

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unintentionally” as an adverb can have the following definitions:

- *Not on purpose.*
- *Without intention; in an unintentional manner.*

### Synonyms of "Unintentionally" as an adverb (1 Word)

**accidentally** Without advance planning.  
*They met **accidentally**.*

## Associations of “Unintentionally” (30 Words)

<b>accident</b>	The working of fortune; chance. <i>Four people were killed in a road <b>accident</b>.</i>
<b>accidental</b>	(in Aristotelian thought) relating to or denoting properties which are not essential to a thing's nature. <i>A verdict of <b>accidental</b> death.</i>
<b>accidentally</b>	By chance; inadvertently. <i><b>Accidentally</b> knocked the vase over.</i>
<b>blurt</b>	Utter impulsively. <i>She <b>blurted</b> out the truth.</i>
<b>carelessly</b>	In a casual or reckless way; inattentively. <i>Roadsides are full of litter thrown <b>carelessly</b> by passers by.</i>
<b>casually</b>	Not methodically or according to plan. <i>I wouldn't introduce my family to people I was <b>casually</b> dating.</i>
<b>coincidence</b>	The temporal property of two things happening at the same time. <i>The <b>coincidence</b> of interest between the mining companies and certain politicians.</i>
<b>happen</b>	Happen occur or be the case in the course of events or by chance. <i>It <b>happens</b> that today is my birthday.</i>
<b>happenstance</b>	An event that might have been arranged although it was really accidental. <i>An untoward <b>happenstance</b> for Trudy.</i>
<b>inadvertently</b>	Without knowledge or intention. <i>His name had been <b>inadvertently</b> omitted from the list.</i>
<b>incident</b>	(sometimes followed by `to') minor or casual or subordinate in significance or nature or occurring as a chance concomitant or consequence. <i>The <b>incident</b> angle.</i>
<b>incidentally</b>	Introducing a different topic. <i><b>Incidentally</b> it was many months before the whole truth was discovered.</i>
<b>intentionally</b>	Deliberately; on purpose. <i>He used that word <b>intentionally</b>.</i>
<b>involuntary</b>	Done against someone's will; compulsory. <i>It becoming a hero was <b>involuntary</b> They sank my boat.</i>
<b>occur</b>	Happen; take place. <i>Sexism <b>occurs</b> in many workplaces.</i>
<b>overhear</b>	Hear, usually without the knowledge of the speakers. <i>We <b>overheard</b> the conversation at the next table.</i>

<b><u>unaware</u></b>	(often followed by `of') not aware. <i><b>Unaware</b> of the newborn hope.</i>
<b>unconsciously</b>	Without awareness. <i>Ben smiled <b>unconsciously</b> when he heard her voice.</i>
<b><u>undiscovered</u></b>	Not discovered. <i>The novel had lain <b>undiscovered</b> for years among his papers.</i>
<b><u>unexpected</u></b>	Not expected or regarded as likely to happen. <i>He seemed to have a knack for saying the <b>unexpected</b>.</i>
<b>unexpectedly</b>	In a way that was not expected. <i>Tourist chiefs reported <b>unexpectedly</b> high visitor numbers.</i>
<b>unidentified</b>	Not recognized or identified. <i>An <b>unidentified</b> witness.</i>
<b><u>unintended</u></b>	Not deliberate. <i>The <b>unintended</b> consequences of people's actions.</i>
<b><u>unintentional</u></b>	Not done with purpose or intent. <i>The translation added a layer of <b>unintentional</b> comedy.</i>
<b><u>unknowingly</u></b>	Without knowledge or intention. <i>Every day we are <b>unknowingly</b> exposed to a variety of pesticides.</i>
<b>unknown</b>	An unknown and unexplored region. <i>An <b>unknown</b> island.</i>
<b><u>unnamed</u></b>	Being or having an unknown or unnamed source. <i>An <b>unnamed</b> donor.</i>
<b>unwitting</b>	Not done on purpose; unintentional. <i>His rudeness was <b>unwitting</b>.</i>
<b>unwittingly</b>	Without being aware; unintentionally. <i>Many users <b>unwittingly</b> expose their personal details to strangers online.</i>
