Synonyms of "Uninvolved" as an adjective (20 Words)

cool	Psychologically cool and unenthusiastic unfriendly or unresponsive or showing dislike. <i>It ll be a cool afternoon.</i>
degage	Showing lack of emotional involvement. <i>Adopted a degage pose on the arm of the easy chair.</i>
detached	Not fixed in position. <i>A four bedroomed detached house.</i>

disinterested	Having or feeling no interest in something; uninterested. <i>A banker is under an obligation to give disinterested advice.</i>
dispassionate	Not influenced by strong emotion, and so able to be rational and impartial. <i>She dealt with life's disasters in a calm dispassionate way.</i>
emotionless	Not showing any emotion; unemotional. <i>He kept his emotionless objectivity and faith in the cause he served.</i>
half-hearted	Feeling or showing little interest or enthusiasm.
impassive	Deliberately impassive in manner. <i>Her impassive remoteness.</i>
indifferent	Having no particular interest or sympathy; unconcerned. <i>Has an indifferent singing voice.</i>
lackadaisical	Lacking enthusiasm and determination; carelessly lazy. <i>A lackadaisical defence left Spurs adrift in the second half.</i>
lukewarm	Showing little enthusiasm. <i>The film received a lukewarm reception from critics.</i>
non-committal	Refusing to bind oneself to a particular course of action or view or the like.
passive	Accepting or allowing what happens or what others do, without active response or resistance. <i>Passive resistance.</i>
uncaring	Lacking affection or warm feeling. <i>An uncaring person.</i>
unconcerned	Lacking in interest or care or feeling. <i>The prisoner seems entirely unconcerned as to the outcome of the examination.</i>
unemotional	Unsusceptible to or destitute of or showing no emotion. <i>A flat unemotional voice.</i>
unfeeling	Lacking physical sensation or sensitivity. <i>My mother is a cold unfeeling woman.</i>
uninterested	Having no care or interest in knowing. <i>She appeared totally uninterested.</i>
unmoved	Emotionally unmoved. <i>Her opponents were unmoved and plan to return to court.</i>
unresponsive	Aloof or indifferent. <i>Was unresponsive to her passionate advances.</i>

Usage Examples of "Uninvolved" as an adjective

- *Convicted killers in documentaries sound uninvolved and mechanical.*
- *Being uninvolved he remained objective.*
- *An uninvolved bystander.*
