### Definitions of "Unison" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unison” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Coincidence in pitch of sounds or notes.*
- *Two or more sounds or tones at the same pitch or in octaves.*
- *Occurring together or simultaneously.*
- *Corresponding exactly.*
- *Simultaneous performance or utterance of action or speech.*
- *(music) two or more sounds or tones at the same pitch or in octaves.*
- *A combination of notes, voices, or instruments at the same pitch or (especially when singing) in octaves.*



## Synonyms of "Unison" as a noun (7 Words)

<b>as one</b>	A very poisonous metallic element that has three allotropic forms; arsenic and arsenic compounds are used as herbicides and insecticides and various alloys; found in arsenopyrite and orpiment and realgar.
<b>at once</b>	100 at equal 1 kip in Laos.
<b>at one and the same time</b>	A highly unstable radioactive element (the heaviest of the halogen series); a decay product of uranium and thorium.
<b>at the same moment</b>	100 at equal 1 kip in Laos.

<b>in chorus</b>	A unit of length equal to one twelfth of a foot.

- cantata** A medium-length narrative piece of music for voices with instrumental accompaniment, typically with solos, chorus, and orchestra.
- [choir](#)** The part of a cathedral or large church between the high altar and the nave used by the choir and clergy.  
*A clarinet **choir**.*
- choral** Engaged in or concerned with singing.  
*A **choral** scholar.*
- chorale** A musical composition consisting of or resembling a harmonized version of a chorale.

<b>chorus</b>	A section of text spoken by the chorus in drama. <i>The orchestra lacked polish and the <b>chorus</b> were inclined to rush ahead regardless.</i>
<b>concert</b>	Arrange (something) by mutual agreement or coordination. <i>A <b>concert</b> pianist.</i>
<b>consonance</b>	The property of sounding harmonious. <i>The abrupt quality of the sound is echoed in the final t <b>consonance</b> of discreet and shut.</i>
<b>harmony</b>	A harmonious state of things in general and of their properties (as of colors and sounds); congruity of parts with one another and with the whole. <i>Man and machine in perfect <b>harmony</b>.</i>
<b>honeyed</b>	With honey added. <i>As the wine matures it becomes more <b>honeyed</b>.</i>
<b>hum</b>	Sound with a monotonous hum. <i>The refrigerator is <b>humming</b>.</i>
<b>lyrical</b>	(of literature, art, or music) expressing the writer's emotions in an imaginative and beautiful way. <i>The dancer s <b>lyrical</b> performance.</i>
<b>madrigal</b>	Sing madrigals. <i>The group was <b>madrigaling</b> beautifully.</i>
<b>mellifluous</b>	(of a sound) pleasingly smooth and musical to hear. <i>Her low <b>mellifluous</b> voice.</i>
<b>melodious</b>	Pleasant-sounding. <i>The <b>melodious</b> chant of the monks.</i>
<b>musical</b>	Characterized by or capable of producing music. <i>They burst out into rich <b>musical</b> laughter.</i>
<b>orchestra</b>	The part of a theatre where the orchestra plays typically in front of the stage and on a lower level.
<b>perfect</b>	The perfect tense. <i>Equity will not <b>perfect</b> an <b>imperfect</b> gift.</i>
<b>performing</b>	The performance of a part or role in a drama.
<b>philharmonic</b>	A large orchestra; can perform symphonies. <i>The most <b>philharmonic</b> ear is at times deeply affected by a simple air.</i>
<b>playing</b>	The act of playing a musical instrument.
<b>rhapsody</b>	(in ancient Greece) an epic poem adapted for recitation. <i>Rhapsodies of praise.</i>

<b>singing</b>	The act of singing vocal music. <i>The <b>singing</b> of hymns in Latin.</i>
<b>solfege</b>	A voice exercise; singing scales or runs to the same syllable.
<b>sonata</b>	A composition for an instrumental soloist often with a piano accompaniment typically in several movements with one or more in sonata form.
<b>sonorous</b>	Capable of producing a deep or ringing sound. <i>He relished the <b>sonorous</b> words of condemnation.</i>
<b><u>super</u></b>	An extra unwanted or unimportant person a supernumerary. <i>A <b>super</b> experiment.</i>
<b>symphonic</b>	Relating to or characteristic or suggestive of a symphony. <i><b>Symphonic</b> and chamber music.</i>
<b><u>symphony</u></b>	A long and complex sonata for symphony orchestra. <i>Autumn is a <b>symphony</b> of texture and pattern.</i>
<b>techno</b>	A style of fast heavy electronic dance music usually without vocals.
