## Synonyms of "Unknowing" as an adjective (12 Words)

<b>adventitious</b>	Formed accidentally or in an unusual anatomical position. <i><b>Adventitious</b> lobes may appear between the primaries.</i>
<b>aleatory</b>	Relating to or denoting music or other forms of art involving elements of random choice (sometimes using statistical or computer techniques) during their composition, production, or performance. <i><b>Aleatory</b> music.</i>
<b><a href="#">casual</a></b>	Hasty and without attention to detail; not thorough. <i>A difficult feat performed with <b>casual</b> mastery.</i>
<b>chance</b>	Occurring or appearing or singled out by chance. <i>A <b>chance</b> meeting.</i>
<b><a href="#">coincidental</a></b>	Occurring or operating at the same time. <i>Any resemblance between their reports is purely <b>coincidental</b>.</i>
<b>fluky</b>	Obtained or achieved more by chance than skill. <i>Getting that job was definitely <b>fluky</b>.</i>
<b><a href="#">fortuitous</a></b>	Having no cause or apparent cause. <i>Profits were enhanced by a <b>fortuitous</b> drop in the cost of raw materials.</i>
<b>ignorant</b>	Lacking knowledge or awareness in general; uneducated or unsophisticated. <i>This <b>ignorant</b> pin brained receptionist.</i>
<b>random</b>	Unfamiliar or unspecified. <i>Apparently <b>random</b> violence.</i>
<b><a href="#">serendipitous</a></b>	Lucky in making unexpected and fortunate discoveries. <i>A <b>serendipitous</b> encounter.</i>
<b>unknowledgeable</b>	Not well informed or educated. <i>Services staffed by <b>unknowledgeable</b> people.</i>
<b>unwitting</b>	Not aware or knowing. <i>An <b>unwitting</b> subject in an experiment.</i>
