Unlikeable as an Adjective

Definitions of "Unlikeable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unlikeable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Difficult or impossible to like.*
- *(of characters in literature or drama) tending to evoke antipathetic feelings.*
- *(especially of a person) not likeable.*
- *Tending to evoke antipathetic feelings.*



Synonyms of "Unlikeable" as an adjective (6 Words)

<u>disagreeable</u>	Unpleasant or unenjoyable. <i>Found the task disagreeable and decided to abandon it.</i>
unappealing	Tending to evoke antipathetic feelings. <i>Was forced to talk to his singularly unappealing hostess.</i>
<u>unattractive</u>	Not appealing to the senses. <i>He was an extremely unattractive man with no sex appeal.</i>
unlikable	Tending to evoke antipathetic feelings. <i>A disagreeable and unlikable old woman.</i>
unlovable	Incapable of inspiring love or affection-Joseph Conrad. <i>She was in some mysterious way unlovable.</i>

(of characters in literature or drama) tending to evoke antipathetic
unsympathetic feelings.

*A job temperamentally **unsympathetic** to him.*



Usage Examples of "Unlikeable" as an adjective
