- (especially of a person) not likeable.
- Tending to evoke antipathetic feelings.

disagreeable Unpleasant or unenjoyable.

Found the task **disagreeable** and decided to abandon it.

unappealingTending to evoke antipathetic feelings.

Was forced to talk to his singularly **unappealing** hostess.

Not appealing to the senses.

unattractive
He was an extremely unattractive man with no sex appeal.

unlikable Tending to evoke antipathetic feelings.

A disagreeable and **unlikable** old woman.

unlovable Incapable of inspiring love or affection-Joseph Conrad.

She was in some mysterious way **unlovable**.



(of characters in literature or drama) tending to evoke antipathetic ${\bf unsympathetic}$ feelings.

A job temperamentally **unsympathetic** to him.
