**expressly** Explicitly; clearly.

She was **expressly** forbidden to use the stove.

flagrant Conspicuously and outrageously bad or reprehensible.

A **flagrant** violation of the law.

In a highly obvious or conspicuous manner.

The reason was **glaringly** obvious.

**incontestable** Not able to be disputed.

indubitable Too obvious to be doubted.

An **indubitable** truth.

In a manner or to a degree that could not be doubted.

**indubitably** It was immediately and **indubitably** apparent that I had interrupted a

**Declared** or made righteous in the sight of God.

A neatly **justified** list of names.

limpid (especially of writing or music) clear and accessible or melodious.

**Limpid** blue eyes.

**lucid** Expressed clearly; easy to understand.

A **lucid** thinker.

**obvious** Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind.

It was **obvious** a storm was coming in.

**palpability** The quality of being perceivable by touch.

He was **unequivocal** in condemning the violence.
