cosmetic Serving an esthetic rather than a useful purpose.

dispensable Able to be replaced or done without; superfluous.

disposable (of a person or idea) able to be dispensed with; easily dismissed.

expendable Remaining after taxes.

The region is **expendable** in the wider context of national politics.

extraneous Separate from the object to which it is attached.

Relying upon an extraneous income.

Without cause.

gratuitous

A qratuitous insult.

(sometimes followed by `to') minor or casual or subordinate in significance

incidental or nature or occurring as a chance concomitant or consequence.

The road will bring other **incidental** advantages.

inessential Not basic or fundamental.

Inessential information.

needless (of something undesirable) not necessary because avoidable.

I deplore **needless** waste.

not required Necessary for relief or supply.

optional Possible but not necessary; left to personal choice.

A wide range of **optional** excursions is offered.

peripheral Of secondary or minor importance; marginal.

The **peripheral** areas of Europe.

Having little or no sense, use, or purpose.

A **pointless** remark.

Done or made with no discernible point or purpose.

purposeless Purposeless vandalism.

redundant
Not or no longer needed or useful; superfluous.

Most of the inflactional and in so are redundant.

Most of the inflectional endings are **redundant**.

to no avail

Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for

indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.

to no purpose Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for

indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.

trivial Concerned with trivialities.

A trivial young woman.

undesired (especially of an act or consequence) not wanted or desired.

An **undesired** result.

unimportant Devoid of importance, meaning, or force.

A relatively **unimportant** feature of the system.

unmerited Not merited or deserved.

Received an **unmerited** honorary degree.



unnecessary More than is needed; excessive.

Good construction is essential to avoid **unnecessary** waste.

unwarrantedUnwarranted jealousy.

Having no beneficial use or incapable of functioning usefully.

We tried to pacify him but it was **useless**.
