<u>avoidable</u>	Able to be avoided or prevented. <i>The accident was entirely avoidable.</i>
cosmetic	Serving an esthetic rather than a useful purpose. <i>Cosmetic surgery.</i>
dispensable	Able to be replaced or done without; superfluous. <i>The captain's loss of form made him dispensable.</i>
<u>disposable</u>	(of a person or idea) able to be dispensed with; easily dismissed. <i>Disposable assets.</i>

expendable	Remaining after taxes. <i>The region is expendable in the wider context of national politics.</i>
extraneous	Separate from the object to which it is attached. <i>Relying upon an extraneous income.</i>
gratuitous	Without cause. <i>A gratuitous insult.</i>
incidental	(sometimes followed by `to') minor or casual or subordinate in significance or nature or occurring as a chance concomitant or consequence. <i>The road will bring other incidental advantages.</i>
inessential	Not basic or fundamental. <i>Inessential information.</i>
needless	(of something undesirable) not necessary because avoidable. <i>I deplore needless waste.</i>
not required	Necessary for relief or supply.
<u>optional</u>	Possible but not necessary; left to personal choice. <i>A wide range of optional excursions is offered.</i>
peripheral	Of secondary or minor importance; marginal. <i>The peripheral areas of Europe.</i>
<u>pointless</u>	Having little or no sense, use, or purpose. <i>A pointless remark.</i>
purposeless	Done or made with no discernible point or purpose. <i>Purposeless vandalism.</i>
redundant	Not or no longer needed or useful; superfluous. <i>Most of the inflectional endings are redundant.</i>
to no avail	Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.
to no purpose	Quantifier; used with either mass nouns or plural count nouns for indicating a complete or almost complete lack or zero quantity of.
<u>trivial</u>	Concerned with trivialities. <i>A trivial young woman.</i>
undesired	(especially of an act or consequence) not wanted or desired. <i>An undesired result.</i>
<u>unimportant</u>	Devoid of importance, meaning, or force. <i>A relatively unimportant feature of the system.</i>
unmerited	Not merited or deserved. <i>Received an unmerited honorary degree.</i>

unnecessary	More than is needed; excessive. <i>Good construction is essential to avoid unnecessary waste.</i>
<u>unwanted</u>	Not wanted; not needed. <i>She felt unwanted.</i>
<u>unwarranted</u>	Not justified or authorized. <i>Unwarranted jealousy.</i>
<u>useless</u>	Having no beneficial use or incapable of functioning usefully. <i>We tried to pacify him but it was useless.</i>
