- Not capable of being obtained.





Synonyms of "Unobtainable" as an adjective (10 Words)

hopeless Without hope because there seems to be no possibility of comfort or success.

She handed me a **hopeless** jumble of papers.



implausible Having a quality that provokes disbelief.

Gave the teacher an **implausible** excuse.

impracticable Not capable of being carried out or put into practice.

Refloating the sunken ship proved **impracticable** because of its fragility.

(of a person) not skilled or interested in doing practical work.

impractical

An impractical solution.

inaccessible Unable to be used.

High culture is largely **inaccessible** to the masses.

unachievable Impossible to achieve.

An **unachievable** political goal.

unattainable Impossible to achieve. An **unattainable** goal.

unprocurable Not capable of being obtained.

Of or belonging to the lowest-caste Hindu group or the people outside the

untouchable caste system.

Drug barons who were legally untouchable.

unworkable Not able to function or be carried out successfully; impractical.

The alloy becomes brittle and almost unworkable.

Usage Examples of "Unobtainable" as an adjective

• The book was unobtainable in London so I wrote to the publisher.

• Timber is virtually unobtainable in the islands.
