Synonyms of "Unoriginal" as an adjective (3 Words)

dull	Blunted in responsiveness or sensibility. <i>There was a dull pain in his lower jaw.</i>
<u>monotonous</u>	Sounded or spoken in a tone unvarying in pitch. <i>Her slurred monotonous speech.</i>
<u>tedious</u>	Using or containing too many words. <i>A tedious journey.</i>

Usage Examples of "Unoriginal" as an adjective

- *The manuscript contained unoriginal emendations.*
- *His life had been unoriginal, conforming completely to the given pattern.*
- *An uninteresting and unoriginal essay.*
