# **Conjugate Unpay**

#### **Unpay in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>unpay</b>	We <b>unpay</b>
You <b>unpay</b>	You <b>unpay</b>
He/She/It <b>unpays</b>	They <b>unpay</b>

## **Unpay in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am unpaying	We <b>are unpaying</b>
You <b>are unpaying</b>	You <b>are unpaying</b>
He/She/It is unpaying	They <b>are unpaying</b>

## **Unpay in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have unpaid	We <b>have unpaid</b>
You <b>have unpaid</b>	You <b>have unpaid</b>
He/She/It has unpaid	They have unpaid

# **Unpay in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been unpaying	We have been unpaying
You <b>have been unpaying</b>	You have been unpaying
He/She/It has been unpaying	They have been unpaying

# **Unpay in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>unpaid</b>	We <b>unpaid</b>
You <b>unpaid</b>	You <b>unpaid</b>
He/She/It <b>unpaid</b>	They <b>unpaid</b>

#### **Unpay in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I was unpaying	We were unpaying
You <b>were unpaying</b>	You were unpaying
He/She/It was unpaying	They were unpaying

## **Unpay in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had unpaid	We <b>had unpaid</b>
You <b>had unpaid</b>	You <b>had unpaid</b>
He/She/It had unpaid	They had unpaid

## **Unpay in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been unpaying	We had been unpaying
You <b>had been unpaying</b>	You had been unpaying
He/She/It had been unpaying	They had been unpaying

# **Unpay in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>will unpay</b>	We <b>will unpay</b>
You <b>will unpay</b>	You <b>will unpay</b>
He/She/It will unpay	They <b>will unpay</b>

# **Unpay in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be unpaying	We will be unpaying
You <b>will be unpaying</b>	You <b>will be unpaying</b>
He/She/It will be unpaying	They will be unpaying

## **Unpay in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been unpaying	We <b>will have been unpaying</b>
You <b>will have been unpaying</b>	You <b>will have been unpaying</b>
He/She/It will have been unpaying	They will have been unpaying
