Not efficient or methodical. unmethodical

The project failed through **unmethodical** planning.

unpremeditated (of an act, remark, or state) not thought out or planned beforehand.

Asked an **unpremeditated** question.

Unaware because of a lack of relevant information or knowledge. unwitting

An **unwitting** accomplice.
