<a href="#">clear</a>	Clear and distinct to the senses easily perceptible. <i>Was now <b>clear</b> of the charge of cowardice.</i>
<a href="#">elementary</a>	Of or pertaining to or characteristic of elementary school or elementary education. <i>An <b>elementary</b> astronomy course.</i>
<a href="#">intelligible</a>	Capable of being apprehended or understood. <i><b>Intelligible</b> pronunciation.</i>
<a href="#">obvious</a>	Easily perceived by the senses or grasped by the mind. <i>It was an <b>obvious</b> remark to make.</i>

<b>self-evident</b>	Evident without proof or argument.
<b>simple</b>	Unornamented. A <b>simple</b> white blouse.
<b>straightforward</b>	Without concealment or deception; honest. A <b>straightforward</b> gaze.
<b>unambiguous</b>	Not open to more than one interpretation. Instructions should be <b>unambiguous</b> .
<b>uncomplicated</b>	Lacking complexity. Small and <b>uncomplicated</b> cars for those really interested in motoring.
<b>user-friendly</b>	Easy to use.
