Definitions of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "unquestionable" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Not able to be disputed or doubted.
- Incapable of being questioned.
- Not open to question.
- Not counterfeit or copied.

Synonyms of "Unquestionable" as an adjective (14 Words)

<u>authentic</u>	Made or done in the traditional or original way, or in a way that faithfully resembles an original. The letter is now accepted as an authentic document.
bona fide	Not counterfeit or copied.
incontestable	Not open to question; obviously true.
incontrovertible	Necessarily or demonstrably true. <i>Incontrovertible proof.</i>
indisputable	Impossible to doubt or dispute. A far from indisputable fact.



indubitable	Too obvious to be doubted. An indubitable truth.
irrefutable	Impossible to deny or disprove. <i>Irrefutable</i> evidence.
<u>unambiguous</u>	Admitting of no doubt or misunderstanding; having only one meaning or interpretation and leading to only one conclusion. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely unambiguous.</i>
<u>unassailable</u>	Impossible to assail. An unassailable lead.
<u>undeniable</u>	Unable to be denied or disputed. It is an undeniable fact that some dogs are easier to train than others.
undoubted	Not questioned or doubted by anyone. <i>Her undoubted ability.</i>
<u>unequivocal</u>	Clearly defined or formulated. <i>Unequivocal evidence.</i>
unimpeachable	Free of guilt; not subject to blame. An unimpeachable witness.
<u>veritable</u>	Often used as intensifiers. Photographs taken in a veritable bull ring.

Usage Examples of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

- An unquestionable antique.
- Unquestionable authority.
- An unquestionable (or unequivocal) loss of prestige.
- His musicianship is unquestionable.
