According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "unquestionable" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Not able to be disputed or doubted.
- Incapable of being questioned.
- Not open to question.
- Not counterfeit or copied.

Synonyms of "Unquestionable" as an adjective (14 Words)

Made or done in the traditional or original way, or in a way that

authentic faithfully resembles an original.

The letter is now accepted as an **authentic** document.

bona fide Not counterfeit or copied.

incontestable Not open to question; obviously true.

incontrovertible Necessarily or demonstrably true.

Incontrovertible proof.

indisputable Impossible to doubt or dispute.

A far from **indisputable** fact.



indubitable Too obvious to be doubted.

An **indubitable** truth.

irrefutable Impossible to deny or disprove.

Irrefutable evidence.

Admitting of no doubt or misunderstanding; having only one meaning or

unambiguous interpretation and leading to only one conclusion.

As a horror apartheid is absolutely **unambiguous**.

unassailable Impossible to assail.

An **unassailable** lead.

undeniable Unable to be denied or disputed.

It is an **undeniable** fact that some dogs are easier to train than others.

undoubted Not questioned or doubted by anyone.

Her **undoubted** ability.

unequivocal Clearly defined or formulated.

Unequivocal evidence.

unimpeachable Free of guilt; not subject to blame.

An **unimpeachable** witness.

veritable Often used as intensifiers.

Photographs taken in a **veritable** bull ring.

Usage Examples of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

• An unquestionable antique.

• Unquestionable authority.

• An unquestionable (or unequivocal) loss of prestige.

• His musicianship is unquestionable.
