### Definitions of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unquestionable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not able to be disputed or doubted.*
- *Incapable of being questioned.*
- *Not open to question.*
- *Not counterfeit or copied.*

### Synonyms of "Unquestionable" as an adjective (14 Words)

<b><a href="#">authentic</a></b>	Made or done in the traditional or original way, or in a way that faithfully resembles an original. <i>The letter is now accepted as an <b>authentic</b> document.</i>
<b>bona fide</b>	Not counterfeit or copied.
<b>incontestable</b>	Not open to question; obviously true.
<b>incontrovertible</b>	Necessarily or demonstrably true. <b>Incontrovertible</b> proof.
<b>indisputable</b>	Impossible to doubt or dispute. <i>A far from <b>indisputable</b> fact.</i>

<b>indubitable</b>	Too obvious to be doubted. <i>An <b>indubitable</b> truth.</i>
<b>irrefutable</b>	Impossible to deny or disprove. <i><b>Irrefutable</b> evidence.</i>
<b><u>unambiguous</u></b>	Admitting of no doubt or misunderstanding; having only one meaning or interpretation and leading to only one conclusion. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely <b>unambiguous</b>.</i>
<b><u>unassailable</u></b>	Impossible to assail. <i>An <b>unassailable</b> lead.</i>
<b><u>undeniable</u></b>	Unable to be denied or disputed. <i>It is an <b>undeniable</b> fact that some dogs are easier to train than others.</i>
<b>undoubted</b>	Not questioned or doubted by anyone. <i>Her <b>undoubted</b> ability.</i>
<b><u>unequivocal</u></b>	Clearly defined or formulated. <i><b>Unequivocal</b> evidence.</i>
<b>unimpeachable</b>	Free of guilt; not subject to blame. <i>An <b>unimpeachable</b> witness.</i>
<b><u>veritable</u></b>	Often used as intensifiers. <i>Photographs taken in a <b>veritable</b> bull ring.</i>

- *His musicianship is unquestionable.*
