Definitions of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “unquestionable” as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- *Not able to be disputed or doubted.*
- *Incapable of being questioned.*
- *Not open to question.*
- *Not counterfeit or copied.*

Synonyms of "Unquestionable" as an adjective (14 Words)

authentic	Made or done in the traditional or original way, or in a way that faithfully resembles an original. <i>The letter is now accepted as an authentic document.</i>
bona fide	Not counterfeit or copied.
incontestable	Not open to question; obviously true.
incontrovertible	Necessarily or demonstrably true. Incontrovertible proof.
indisputable	Impossible to doubt or dispute. <i>A far from indisputable fact.</i>

indubitable	Too obvious to be doubted. <i>An indubitable truth.</i>
irrefutable	Impossible to deny or disprove. <i>Irrefutable evidence.</i>
<u>unambiguous</u>	Admitting of no doubt or misunderstanding; having only one meaning or interpretation and leading to only one conclusion. <i>As a horror apartheid is absolutely unambiguous.</i>
<u>unassailable</u>	Impossible to assail. <i>An unassailable lead.</i>
<u>undeniable</u>	Unable to be denied or disputed. <i>It is an undeniable fact that some dogs are easier to train than others.</i>
undoubted	Not questioned or doubted by anyone. <i>Her undoubted ability.</i>
<u>unequivocal</u>	Clearly defined or formulated. <i>Unequivocal evidence.</i>
unimpeachable	Free of guilt; not subject to blame. <i>An unimpeachable witness.</i>
<u>veritable</u>	Often used as intensifiers. <i>Photographs taken in a veritable bull ring.</i>

Usage Examples of "Unquestionable" as an adjective

- *An unquestionable antique.*
- *Unquestionable authority.*
- *An unquestionable (or unequivocal) loss of prestige.*
- *His musicianship is unquestionable.*
