
Unreachable as an Adjective

remote

Situated far from a centre; remote.

Outlying settlements.

Denoting a device which can only be accessed by means of a

network.

A remote possibility.

unapproachable

Inaccessibly located or situated.

Some regions were **unapproachable** to the Romans.

Not yet reached, especially by people seeking to convert others

to Christianity.

unreached

The Church's awareness of the unreached groups within a

nation.
