Located in a dismal or remote area; desolate.
*What are you doing in this **godforsaken** place.*

hard to find

Not easy; requiring great physical or mental effort to accomplish or comprehend or endure.

in the back of beyond

Holding office.

in the depths of ...

Holding office.

in the hinterlands

Holding office.

in the middle of nowhere

Directed or bound inward.

inaccessible

(of language or an artistic work) difficult to understand or appreciate.
*Such costs would make litigation **inaccessible** to private individuals.*

isolated

Cut off or left behind.
*Could not remain the **isolated** figure he had been.*

lonely	(of a place) unfrequented and remote. <i>A lonely fisherman stood on a tuft of gravel.</i>
obscure	Not famous or acclaimed. <i>Those who do not appreciate Kafka s work say his style is obscure.</i>
off the beaten track	Not in operation or operational.
off the map	Not performing or scheduled for duties.
out of reach	Directed outward or serving to direct something outward.
out of the way	Being out or having grown cold.
outlying	Situated far from a centre; remote. <i>Outlying settlements.</i>
remote	Denoting a device which can only be accessed by means of a network. <i>A remote possibility.</i>
unapproachable	Inaccessibly located or situated. <i>Some regions were unapproachable to the Romans.</i>
unreached	Not yet reached, especially by people seeking to convert others to Christianity. <i>The Church s awareness of the unreached groups within a nation.</i>
