Synonyms of "Unrealistic" as an adjective (8 Words)

abstract

Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or intention.

Abstract science.

impracticable

Not capable of being carried out or put into practice.

*Refloating the sunken ship proved **impracticable** because of its fragility.*

impractical

Not practical; not workable or not given to practical matters.

Impractical high heels.

unfeasible

Not capable of being carried out or put into practice.

*A suggested reform that was **unfeasible** in the prevailing circumstances.*

unlifelike

Without substance.

unnatural	(of feelings or behaviour) contrary to what is seen as normal, conventional, or acceptable. <i>Death by unnatural causes.</i>
unrepresentative	Not typical of a class, group, or body of opinion. <i>Behavior quite unrepresentative or atypical of the profession.</i>
unworkable	Not capable of being carried out or put into practice. <i>An unworkable scheme.</i>



Usage Examples of "Unrealistic" as an adjective

- *Unrealistic expectations.*
- *Prices at unrealistic high levels.*
