Definitions of "Unrealistic" as an adjective

Synonyms of "Unrealistic" as an adjective (8 Words)

<u>abstract</u>	Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or intention. <i>Abstract science.</i>
impracticable	Not capable of being carried out or put into practice. <i>Refloating the sunken ship proved impracticable because of its fragility.</i>
<u>impractical</u>	Not practical; not workable or not given to practical matters. <i>Impractical high heels.</i>
unfeasible	Not capable of being carried out or put into practice. <i>A suggested reform that was unfeasible in the prevailing circumstances.</i>
unlifelike	Without substance.

- unnatural** (of feelings or behaviour) contrary to what is seen as normal, conventional, or acceptable.
*Death by **unnatural** causes.*
- unrepresentative** Not typical of a class, group, or body of opinion.
*Behavior quite **unrepresentative** or atypical of the profession.*
- unworkable** Not capable of being carried out or put into practice.
*An **unworkable** scheme.*



Usage Examples of "Unrealistic" as an adjective

- *It was unrealistic to expect changes to be made overnight.*
- *Unrealistic expectations.*
- *Prices at unrealistic high levels.*
