unfeasible A suggested reform that was **unfeasible** in the prevailing

circumstances.

unlifelike Without substance.



(of feelings or behaviour) contrary to what is seen as normal,

unnatural conventional, or acceptable.


Death by **unnatural** causes.

unrepresentative Not typical of a class, group, or body of opinion.

Behavior quite **unrepresentative** or atypical of the profession.

unworkable Not capable of being carried out or put into practice.

An **unworkable** scheme.
