### Definitions of "Unspoken" as an adjective

- *Not made explicit.*
- *Not expressed in speech; tacit.*
- *Expressed without speech- Emily Dickinson- Thomas Wolfe.*

### Synonyms of "Unspoken" as an adjective (16 Words)

<b>mute</b>	Expressed without speech- Emily Dickinson- Thomas Wolfe. <i>She gazed at him in <b>mute</b> appeal.</i>
<b>silent</b>	Failing to speak or communicate etc when expected to. <i>A <b>silent</b> dog whistle.</i>
<b>tongueless</b>	Expressed without speech- Emily Dickinson- Thomas Wolfe. <i>Best grief is <b>tongueless</b>.</i>
<b>unarticulated</b>	Not consisting of segments that are held together by joints. <i>Previously <b>unarticulated</b> anger.</i>

<b>unavowed</b>	Not openly expressed. <i>An underlying <b>unavowed</b> hostility.</i>
<b>undeclared</b>	Not publicly announced, admitted, or acknowledged. <i>Fighting an <b>undeclared</b> war.</i>
<b>unexpressed</b>	(of a thought or feeling) not communicated or made known. <i>He thought it best to leave his doubts <b>unexpressed</b>.</i>
<b>unmentioned</b>	Not mentioned. <i>A monument <b>unmentioned</b> in all the architectural guides.</i>
<b>unsaid</b>	Not made explicit. <i>Things left <b>unsaid</b>.</i>
<b>unstated</b>	Not made explicit. <i>His action is clear but his reason remains <b>unstated</b>.</i>
<b>unuttered</b>	(of words or thoughts) not spoken or expressed. <i>Her lips mouthed <b>unuttered</b> thanks.</i>
<b>unverbalised</b>	Not made explicit.
<b>unverbalized</b>	Not made explicit.
<b>unvoiced</b>	Produced without vibration of the vocal cords. <i><b>Unvoiced</b> consonants such as p and k and s.</i>
<b>voiceless</b>	Produced without vibration of the vocal cords. <i>Millions of Americans feel <b>voiceless</b> and powerless to bring positive change to the political system.</i>
<b>wordless</b>	(of a play, book, or other work) without words or speech. <i>Choking exasperation and <b>wordless</b> shame.</i>
