- *(especially used in traditional Hindu belief of the lowest caste or castes) defiling.*
- *Not able or allowed to be touched or affected.*
- *Not capable of being obtained.*
- *Of or belonging to the lowest-caste Hindu group or the people outside the caste system.*
- *Beyond the reach of criticism or attack or impeachment- Newsweek.*
- *Forbidden to the touch.*
- *Defiling.*
- *Impossible to assail.*

- *Beyond the reach of criticism or attack or impeachment.*
- *Unable to be matched or rivalled.*



Synonyms of "Untouchable" as an adjective (18 Words)

<u>abstract</u>	Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or intention. <i>We have been discussing the problem in a very abstract manner.</i>
bodiless	Lacking a body. <i>Bodiless ghosts.</i>
disembodied	(of a sound) lacking any obvious physical source. <i>A disembodied ghost.</i>
impalpable	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>As impalpable as a dream.</i>

inaccessible	Not capable of being obtained. <i>High culture is largely inaccessible to the masses.</i>
incorporeal	Not composed of matter; having no material existence. <i>A supreme but incorporeal being called God.</i>
indefinable	Not able to be defined or described exactly. <i>She reminds me in some indefinable way of my grandmother.</i>
<u>indescribable</u>	Defying expression or description. <i>Most prisoners suffered indescribable hardship.</i>
indistinct	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i>An indistinct memory.</i>
<u>intangible</u>	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>The rose symbolized something intangible about their relationship.</i>
<u>invisible</u>	Relating to or denoting earnings which a country makes from the sale of services or other items not constituting tangible commodities. <i>An invisible hinge.</i>
<u>obscure</u>	Not discovered or known about; uncertain. <i>An obscure village.</i>
<u>unassailable</u>	Impossible to assail. <i>An unassailable lead.</i>
<u>unclear</u>	Poorly stated or described. <i>Their future remains unclear.</i>
unembodied	Not having a material body. <i>Divine and unembodied power.</i>
<u>unobtainable</u>	Not able to be obtained. <i>Timber is virtually unobtainable in the islands.</i>
unprocurable	Not capable of being obtained.
<u>vague</u>	Of uncertain, indefinite, or unclear character or meaning. <i>Vague forms of speech have so long passed for mysteries of science.</i>



Usage Examples of "Untouchable" as an adjective

- *For the first time criticism was directed at a hitherto untouchable target.*
- *Drug barons who were legally untouchable.*
- *When the band retreat to ambience and minimalism, they are untouchable.*
- *Untouchable resources buried deep within the earth.*
- *In most museums such articles are untouchable.*
