

- (especially used in traditional Hindu belief of the lowest caste or castes) defiling.
- Not able or allowed to be touched or affected.
- Not capable of being obtained.
- Of or belonging to the lowest-caste Hindu group or the people outside the caste system.
- Beyond the reach of criticism or attack or impeachment- Newsweek.
- Forbidden to the touch.
- Defiling.
- Impossible to assail.

- Unable to be matched or rivalled.




Synonyms of "Untouchable" as an adjective (18 Words)

<u>abstract</u>	Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or intention. We have been discussing the problem in a very abstract manner.
bodiless	Lacking a body. Bodiless ghosts.
disembodied	(of a sound) lacking any obvious physical source. A disembodied ghost.
impalpable	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>As impalpable as a dream.</i>



inaccessible	Not capable of being obtained. <i>High culture is largely inaccessible to the masses.</i>
incorporeal	Not composed of matter; having no material existence. A supreme but incorporeal being called God.
indefinable	Not able to be defined or described exactly. <i>She reminds me in some indefinable way of my grandmother.</i>
<u>indescribable</u>	Defying expression or description. Most prisoners suffered indescribable hardship.
indistinct	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i>An indistinct memory.</i>
<u>intangible</u>	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>The rose symbolized something intangible about their relationship.</i>
<u>invisible</u>	Relating to or denoting earnings which a country makes from the sale of services or other items not constituting tangible commodities. <i>An invisible hinge.</i>
<u>obscure</u>	Not discovered or known about; uncertain. An obscure village.
<u>unassailable</u>	Impossible to assail. An unassailable lead.
<u>unclear</u>	Poorly stated or described. <i>Their future remains unclear</i> .
unembodied	Not having a material body. Divine and unembodied power.
<u>unobtainable</u>	Not able to be obtained. <i>Timber is virtually</i> unobtainable <i>in the islands.</i>
unprocurable	Not capable of being obtained.
<u>vague</u>	Of uncertain, indefinite, or unclear character or meaning. Vague forms of speech have so long passed for mysteries of science.





Usage Examples of "Untouchable" as an adjective

- For the first time criticism was directed at a hitherto untouchable target.
- Drug barons who were legally untouchable.
- When the band retreat to ambience and minimalism, they are untouchable.
- Untouchable resources buried deep within the earth.
- In most museums such articles are untouchable.
