- *Not able or allowed to be touched or affected.*
- *Not capable of being obtained.*
- *Of or belonging to the lowest-caste Hindu group or the people outside the caste system.*
- *Beyond the reach of criticism or attack or impeachment- Newsweek.*
- *Forbidden to the touch.*
- *Defiling.*
- *Impossible to assail.*

- *Unable to be matched or rivalled.*

<b><u>abstract</u></b>	Dealing with a subject in the abstract without practical purpose or intention. <i>We have been discussing the problem in a very <b>abstract</b> manner.</i>
<b>bodiless</b>	Lacking a body. <i><b>Bodiless</b> ghosts.</i>
<b>disembodied</b>	(of a sound) lacking any obvious physical source. <i>A <b>disembodied</b> ghost.</i>
<b>impalpable</b>	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>As <b>impalpable</b> as a dream.</i>

<b>inaccessible</b>	Not capable of being obtained. <i>High culture is largely <b>inaccessible</b> to the masses.</i>
<b>incorporeal</b>	Not composed of matter; having no material existence. <i>A supreme but <b>incorporeal</b> being called God.</i>
<b>indefinable</b>	Not able to be defined or described exactly. <i>She reminds me in some <b>indefinable</b> way of my grandmother.</i>
<b><u>indescribable</u></b>	Defying expression or description. <i>Most prisoners suffered <b>indescribable</b> hardship.</i>
<b>indistinct</b>	Not clearly defined or easy to perceive or understand. <i>An <b>indistinct</b> memory.</i>
<b><u>intangible</u></b>	Incapable of being perceived by the senses especially the sense of touch- James Jeans. <i>The rose symbolized something <b>intangible</b> about their relationship.</i>
<b><u>invisible</u></b>	Relating to or denoting earnings which a country makes from the sale of services or other items not constituting tangible commodities. <i>An <b>invisible</b> hinge.</i>
<b><u>obscure</u></b>	Not discovered or known about; uncertain. <i>An <b>obscure</b> village.</i>
<b><u>unassailable</u></b>	Impossible to assail. <i>An <b>unassailable</b> lead.</i>
<b><u>unclear</u></b>	Poorly stated or described. <i>Their future remains <b>unclear</b>.</i>
<b>unembodied</b>	Not having a material body. <i>Divine and <b>unembodied</b> power.</i>
<b><u>unobtainable</u></b>	Not able to be obtained. <i>Timber is virtually <b>unobtainable</b> in the islands.</i>
<b>unprocurable</b>	Not capable of being obtained.
<b><u>vague</u></b>	Of uncertain, indefinite, or unclear character or meaning. <i><b>Vague</b> forms of speech have so long passed for mysteries of science.</i>



## Usage Examples of "Untouchable" as an adjective

- *For the first time criticism was directed at a hitherto untouchable target.*
- *Drug barons who were legally untouchable.*
- *When the band retreat to ambience and minimalism, they are untouchable.*
- *Untouchable resources buried deep within the earth.*
