<a href="#">airy</a>	Delicate, as though filled with or made of air. <i><b>Airy</b> rooms.</i>
<b>beaming</b>	Smiling broadly; grinning. <i>The <b>beaming</b> sun.</i>
<b>breezy</b>	Fresh and animated. <i>It was a bright <b>breezy</b> day.</i>
<a href="#">bright</a>	Not made dim or less bright. <i>The sun was <b>bright</b> and hot.</i>
<a href="#">bubbly</a>	(of a person) full of cheerful high spirits. <i>A bright and <b>bubbly</b> personality.</i>

<b>carefree</b>	Cheerfully irresponsible. <i>Carefree millionaires untroubled financially.</i>
<b><u>cheerful</u></b>	Being full of or promoting cheer; having or showing good spirits. <i>How can she be so <b>cheerful</b> at six o'clock in the morning.</i>
<b>cheery</b>	Happy and optimistic. <i>A <b>cheery</b> hello.</i>
<b><u>ebullient</u></b>	(of liquid or matter) boiling or agitated as if boiling. <i>Misted and <b>ebullient</b> seas.</i>
<b><u>effervescent</u></b>	Used of wines and waters; charged naturally or artificially with carbon dioxide. <i>His fertile <b>effervescent</b> mind.</i>
<b>exuberant</b>	Characterized by a vigorously imaginative artistic style. <i><b>Exuberant</b> compliments.</i>
<b>grinning</b>	Smiling broadly. <i>A <b>grinning</b> skull.</i>
<b>happy</b>	Used in greetings. <i>I'm <b>happy</b> with his performance.</i>
<b>in good spirits</b>	Directed or bound inward.
<b>in high spirits</b>	Holding office.
<b>jaunty</b>	Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air. <i>There was no mistaking that <b>jaunty</b> walk.</i>
<b><u>jolly</u></b>	Lively and entertaining. <i>He was a <b>jolly</b> man full of jokes.</i>
<b><u>joyous</u></b>	Full of happiness and joy. <i>Scenes of <b>joyous</b> celebration.</i>
<b>laughing</b>	Showing or feeling mirth or pleasure or happiness. <i><b>Laughing</b> children.</i>
<b>light-hearted</b>	Carefree and happy and lighthearted.
<b><u>merry</u></b>	Full of or showing high-spirited merriment- Wordsworth. <i>After the third beer he began to feel quite <b>merry</b>.</i>
<b>mirthful</b>	Full of or showing high-spirited merriment. <i>A <b>mirthful</b> experience.</i>
<b>radiant</b>	Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or heating. <i>He praised her <b>radiant</b> self confidence.</i>
<b>smiling</b>	Smiling with happiness or optimism. <i><b>Smiling</b> groves and terraces.</i>

**sparkling** (of a drink) effervescent; fizzy.  
*Sparkling* dialogue.

**sprightly** Full of spirit and vitality.  
*She was quite **sprightly** for her age.*

**sunny** (of a person or their temperament) cheery and bright.  
*A **sunny** smile.*

## Usage Examples of "Unworried" as an adjective

- *Foreign investors are largely unworried by the government's fall.*
