**<u>effervescent</u>** dioxide.

His fertile **effervescent** mind.

**exuberant** Characterized by a vigorously imaginative artistic style.

**Exuberant** compliments.

**grinning** Smiling broadly. *A grinning* skull.

Used in greetings.

I m happy with his performance.

in good spirits Directed or bound inward.

in high spirits Holding office.

jaunty Having a cheerful, lively, and self-confident air.

There was no mistaking that **jaunty** walk.

Lively and entertaining.

jolly

He was a jolly man full of jokes.

Full of happiness and joy.

Scenes of **joyous** celebration.

**hing** Showing or feeling mirth or pleasure or happiness.

**Laughing** Laughing children.

**light-hearted** Carefree and happy and lighthearted.

Full of or showing high-spirited merriment- Wordsworth.

After the third beer he began to feel quite **merry**.

mirthful Full of or showing high-spirited merriment.

A mirthful experience.

Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or

radiant heating.

He praised her **radiant** self confidence.

Smiling with happiness or optimism.

**Smiling** groves and terraces.



sparkling (of a drink) effervescent; fizzy.

Sparkling dialogue.

sprightly

Full of spirit and vitality.

Showed switz and challenges

She was quite **sprightly** for her age.

(of a person or their temperament) cheery and bright.

A **sunny** smile.
