Definitions of "Unworthy" as an adjective

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "unworthy" as an adjective can have the following definitions:

- Not deserving respect or attention.
- (of an action) not acceptable, especially from someone with a good reputation or social position.
- Morally reprehensible.
- Not deserving.
- Having little merit.
- Lacking in value or merit.





Synonyms of "Unworthy" as an adjective (20 Words)

despicable	Morally reprehensible. A despicable crime.
<u>improper</u>	Not in accordance with accepted standards, especially of morality or honesty. <i>The improper use of public funds.</i>
inappropriate	Not suitable for a particular occasion etc. <i>Put inappropriate pressure on them.</i>



incongruous	Not in harmony or keeping with the surroundings or other aspects of something.
	A joke that was incongruous with polite conversation.
ineligible for	Prohibited by official rules.
not good enough for	Having the normally expected amount.
not worthy	Worthy of being chosen especially as a spouse.
<u>slimy</u>	Morally reprehensible. A slimy cigar puffing political fixer.
<u>unbecoming</u>	(of behaviour) not fitting or appropriate; unseemly. It was unbecoming for a university to do anything so crass as advertising its wares.
unbefitting	Not appropriate; unsuitable. Unbefitting conduct.
undeserving	Not deserving or worthy of something positive, especially help or praise. The undeserving poor.
unfit for	Below the required standards for a purpose.
unfitting	Not in keeping with what is correct or proper. <i>Certain occupations were held unfitting for baptized believers.</i>
unqualified for	Having no right or entitlement.
unseemly	Not in keeping with accepted standards of what is right or proper in polite society. Unseemly to use profanity.
<u>unsuitable</u>	Not meant or adapted for a particular purpose. <i>The display is unsuitable for young children.</i>
vile	Extremely unpleasant. He has a vile temper.
worthless	Morally reprehensible. <i>That promise is worthless</i> .
wretched	Characterized by physical misery. She disliked the wretched man intensely.

Usage Examples of "Unworthy" as an adjective

- Many pieces are unworthy and ungrammatical.
- Unworthy of forgiveness.
- Dispel a student whose conduct is deemed unworthy.



- He was unworthy of trust and unfit to hold office.
- Such a suggestion is unworthy of the Honourable Gentleman.
