Infinitive	to up-end
Present Tense	up-end / up-ends
Past Tense	up-ended
Present Participle	up-ending
Past Participle	up-ended

# **Conjugate Up-end**

#### **Up-end in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**



Singular	Plural
I <b>up-end</b>	We <b>up-end</b>
You <b>up-end</b>	You <b>up-end</b>
He/She/It <b>up-ends</b>	They <b>up-end</b>

## **Up-end in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I am up-ending	We <b>are up-ending</b>
You are up-ending	You <b>are up-ending</b>
He/She/It is up-ending	They are up-ending

## **Up-end in Present Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have up-ended	We have up-ended
You have up-ended	You have up-ended
He/She/It has up-ended	They have up-ended

## **Up-end in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I have been up-ending	We have been up-ending
You <b>have been up-ending</b>	You have been up-ending
He/She/It has been up-ending	They have been up-ending

## **Up-end in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I <b>up-ended</b>	We <b>up-ended</b>
You <b>up-ended</b>	You <b>up-ended</b>
He/She/It up-ended	They <b>up-ended</b>

## **Up-end in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**



SingularPluralI was up-endingWe were up-endingYou were up-endingYou were up-endingHe/She/It was up-endingThey were up-ending

#### **Up-end in Past Perfect Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had up-ended	We had up-ended
You had up-ended	You had up-ended
He/She/It had up-ended	They had up-ended

#### **Up-end in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I had been up-ending	We had been up-ending
You <b>had been up-ending</b>	You had been up-ending
He/She/It had been up-ending	They had been up-ending

## **Up-end in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will up-end	We will up-end
You <b>will up-end</b>	You <b>will up-end</b>
He/She/It will up-end	They will up-end

#### **Up-end in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will be up-ending	We will be up-ending
You <b>will be up-ending</b>	You will be up-ending
He/She/It will be up-ending	They will be up-ending

#### **Up-end in Future Perfect Tense**



Singular	Plural
I will have up-ended	We will have up-ended
You <b>will have up-ended</b>	You will have up-ended
He/She/It will have up-ended	They will have up-ended

## **Up-end in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

Singular	Plural
I will have been up-ending	We will have been up-ending
You <b>will have been up-ending</b>	You <b>will have been up-ending</b>
He/She/It will have been up-ending	They will have been up-ending
