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• Associations of "Upper class" (30 Words)

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alumnus	A former member of a group, company, or organization. A Royal Ballet alumnus .
attendance	The frequency with which a person is present. A student s attendance is an important factor in her grade.
bookworm	A person who pays more attention to formal rules and book learning than they merit.
college	The body of faculty and students of a college. <i>Colleges of further education.</i>
collegian	A student (or former student) at a college or university.
course	A procedure adopted to deal with a situation. She prepared a three course meal.
diploma	An official document or charter.
<u>disciple</u>	A follower or pupil of a teacher, leader, or philosopher. A disciple of Rousseau.
<u>elevation</u>	A high place or position. An elevation of 300 metres.
enrol	Enter (a deed or other document) among the rolls of a court of justice. <i>He enrolled in drama school.</i>
grad	A person who has received a degree from a school (high school or college or university.
<u>graduate</u>	A person who has successfully completed a course of study or training especially a person who has been awarded an undergraduate or first academic degree. <i>She is 19 a graduate of Lincoln High.</i>
graduated	(of an instrument or container) marked with units of measurement. A 15 ml graduated tube.



graduation	The act of arranging in grades. The ruler had 16 graduation s per inch.
homeroom	A classroom in which all students in a particular grade (or in a division of a grade) meet at certain times under the supervision of a teacher who takes attendance and does other administrative business.
lecturer	A public lecturer at certain universities. A senior lecturer in surgery at Leeds University.
matriculate	A person who has matriculated. They had recently matriculate d as undergraduates at Jesus College.
postgraduate	A student engaged in a postgraduate course. A postgraduate degree.
pupil	A trainee barrister. They are former pupil s of the school.
scholastic	Of or relating to the philosophical doctrine of scholasticism. To distinguish between them is little more than a scholastic exercise.
schoolmaster	An experienced horse that is used to train or give confidence to inexperienced riders or horses.
semester	Half a year; a period of 6 months. The opening week of Harvard s autumn semester .
sophomore	A second-year university or high-school student. Freshmen performed better than either sophomore s or juniors.
teach	Work as a teacher. He came one day each week to teach painting.
teaching	Ideas or principles taught by an authority. I went into teaching because I like working with children.
top	Reach the top of a hill or other elevation. <i>He stared as she buttoned her top.</i>
<u>trainee</u>	A person undergoing training for a particular job or profession. <i>Trainee</i> solicitors.
undergraduate	Denoting or relating to an undergraduate. An undergraduate degree.
<u>university</u>	The body of faculty and students at a university. <i>His daughter is at university.</i>
valedictorian	The student with the best grades who usually delivers the valedictory address at commencement.
