Uptake as a Noun

Definitions of "Uptake" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “uptake” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The taking in or absorption of a substance by a living organism or bodily organ.*
- *The process of taking food into the body through the mouth (as by eating).*
- *A process of taking up or using up or consuming.*
- *The action of taking up or making use of something that is available.*

Synonyms of "Uptake" as a noun (3 Words)

consumption	An amount of something which is used up or ingested. <i>Industrialized countries should reduce their energy consumption.</i>
ingestion	The process of taking food, drink, or another substance into the body by swallowing or absorbing it. <i>The effect of caffeine ingestion on exercise performance.</i>
<u>intake</u>	The act of inhaling; the drawing in of air (or other gases) as in breathing. <i>His alcohol intake.</i>

Usage Examples of "Uptake" as a noun

- *The uptake of glucose into the muscles.*
- *They developed paper napkins with a greater uptake of liquids.*

- *The uptake of free school meals.*
