Definitions of "Uptake" as a noun

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "uptake" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- The taking in or absorption of a substance by a living organism or bodily organ.
- The process of taking food into the body through the mouth (as by eating.
- A process of taking up or using up or consuming.
- The action of taking up or making use of something that is available.

Synonyms of "Uptake" as a noun (3 Words)

consumption

An amount of something which is used up or ingested. *Industrialized countries should reduce their energy consumption*.

The process of taking food, drink, or another substance into the body by

ingestion swallowing or absorbing it.

The effect of caffeine **ingestion** on exercise performance.

The act of inhaling; the drawing in of air (or other gases) as in breathing. intake

His alcohol **intake**.

Usage Examples of "Uptake" as a noun

- The uptake of glucose into the muscles.
- They developed paper napkins with a greater uptake of liquids.
