abreast	Alongside or level with something. <i>The path was wide enough for two people to walk abreast.</i>
alongside	Side by side.
chic	Elegance by virtue of being fashionable. <i>She looked every inch the chic Frenchwoman.</i>
craze	An enthusiasm for a particular activity or object which appears suddenly and achieves widespread but short-lived popularity. <i>Crazed by hunger the population began to turn on the rebels.</i>
current	A quantity representing the rate of flow of electric charge, usually measured in amperes. <i>The other meaning of the word is still current.</i>
dapper	Marked by up-to-dateness in dress and manners. <i>A dapper young man.</i>
fad	An intense and widely shared enthusiasm for something, especially one that is short-lived; a craze. <i>His fads about the type of coffee he must have.</i>
faddish	Intensely fashionable for a short time. <i>Superficial faddish approaches to spirituality.</i>
fashion	A popular or the latest style of clothing, hair, decoration, or behaviour. <i>The latest Parisian fashions.</i>
fashionable	Of a place frequented by fashionable people. <i>They risked being scoffed at by their more fashionable friends.</i>
inimitable	So good or unusual as to be impossible to copy; unique. <i>They took the charts by storm with their inimitable style.</i>
lately	In the recent past. <i>Lately the rules have been enforced.</i>

latest	In the current fashion or style. <i>Have you heard the latest.</i>
modern	Belonging to the modern era since the Middle Ages. <i>Their offices are in a modern skyscraper.</i>
modernity	The quality of being current or of the present. <i>Hobbes was the genius of modernity.</i>
modish	Conforming to or following what is currently popular and fashionable. <i>It seems sad that such a scholar should feel compelled to use this modish jargon.</i>
natty	Well designed; clever. <i>A natty blue blazer.</i>
newfangled	Gratuitously new. <i>Newfangled ideas.</i>
newly	Very recently. <i>A newly arranged hairdo.</i>
popular	(of a belief or attitude) held by the majority of the general public. <i>Cabbage patch dolls are no longer popular.</i>
present	Formally present a debutante a representative of a country etc. <i>We presented the arguments to him.</i>
presently	At the present time; now. <i>She will arrive presently.</i>
recency	A time immediately before the present.
recent	Approximately the last 10,000 years. <i>Recent buds on the apple trees.</i>
recently	At a recent time; not long ago. <i>I recently bought a CD player.</i>
stylish	Neat, confident, and skilful. <i>A stylish batsman.</i>
unconventional	Not based on or conforming to what is generally done or believed. <i>His unconventional approach to life.</i>
urbanity	Courteousness and refinement of manner. <i>A picture of banal urbanity.</i>
vogue	The popular taste at a given time. <i>Citizenship was to be the government s vogue word.</i>
whereabouts	The place where someone or something is. <i>Whereabouts do you come from.</i>
