- neatness** The state of being neat and smart and trim.
*His obsessive **neatness**.*
- practicality** Concerned with actual use rather than theoretical possibilities.
*There are still major doubts about the **practicality** of the proposal.*
- serviceability** The quality of being able to provide good service.
- use** The action of using something or the state of being used for a purpose.
*Theatre owners were charging too much for the **use** of their venues.*
- utility** A utility vehicle.
*A handy **utility** for converting one graphics file type to another.*

*It is not **feasible** to put most finds from excavations on public display.*
- handy** (in Europe) a mobile phone.
*A **handy** gadget.*
- likelihood** The state or fact of something's being likely; probability.
*Situations where there is a **likelihood** of violence.*
- operational** Relating to or in accordance with operationalism.
*De facto apartheid is still **operational** even in the new African nations.*
- portable** A small transportable building used as a classroom.
*A **portable** television set.*
- possibility** A thing that may be chosen or done out of several possible alternatives.
*There is a **possibility** that his sense of smell has been impaired.*
- possible** The highest possible score especially in a shooting competition.
*They were living right at the edge of the **possible**.*
- potential** Latent qualities or abilities that may be developed and lead to future success or usefulness.
*Pesticides with the **potential** to cause cancer.*
- practical** Having or put to a practical purpose or use.
*It is merely being **practical** we must find a ground floor flat.*
- pragmatic** Relating to pragmatics.
*A **pragmatic** approach to politics.*

useful	Having a useful function. <i>Aspirins are useful for headaches.</i>
utilitarian	Relating to or adhering to the doctrine of utilitarianism. <i>A utilitarian building.</i>
utilizable	Capable of being put to a profitable or practical use.
<u>utilize</u>	Make practical and effective use of. <i>Vitamin C helps your body utilize the iron present in your diet.</i>
viable	(of a fetus or unborn child) able to live after birth. <i>A viable fetus.</i>
<u>workable</u>	Capable of being done with means at hand and circumstances as they are. <i>A workable peace settlement.</i>
