## Associations of "Vacated" (30 Words)

<b>abandoned</b>	Forsaken by owner or inhabitants. <i>Weed grown yard of an <b>abandoned</b> farmhouse.</i>
<b>abolish</b>	Do away with. <i>Slavery was <b>abolished</b> in the mid 19th century in America and in Russia.</i>
<b>abrogate</b>	Revoke formally. <i>A proposal to <b>abrogate</b> temporarily the right to strike.</i>
<b>abrogation</b>	The act of abrogating; an official or legal cancellation.
<b>annul</b>	Declare (a marriage) to have had no legal existence. <i>The contract was <b>annulled</b>.</i>
<b>annulment</b>	A formal termination (of a relationship or a judicial proceeding etc). <i>The applicant sought the <b>annulment</b> of the decision.</i>
<a href="#">cancel</a>	A notation cancelling a previous sharp or flat. <i>The electric fields may <b>cancel</b> each other out.</i>
<b>countermand</b>	An order revoking a previous one. <i>An order to arrest the strike leaders had been <b>countermanded</b>.</i>
<a href="#">delete</a>	Cut or eliminate. <i>Please <b>delete</b> my name from your list.</i>
<a href="#">deserted</a>	Forsaken by owner or inhabitants. <i><b>Deserted</b> beaches of soft sand.</i>
<a href="#">destitute</a>	Not having. <i>The charity cares for <b>destitute</b> children.</i>
<b>drain</b>	Empty of liquid drain the liquid from. <i>Polly felt the blood <b>drain</b> from her face.</i>
<a href="#">emptiness</a>	An empty area or space. <i>He realizes the <b>emptiness</b> of his statement.</i>
<a href="#">empty</a>	A bottle or glass left empty of its contents. <i>An <b>empty</b> room.</i>

<b><u>invalidate</u></b>	Deprive (an official document or procedure) of legal validity because it contravenes a regulation or law. <i>A technical flaw in her papers <b>invalidated</b> her nomination.</i>
<b><u>island</u></b>	A zone or area resembling an island. <i>This <b>island</b> nation.</i>
<b>nil</b>	A quantity of no importance. <i>They beat us three <b>nil</b>.</i>
<b><u>null</u></b>	Combine a signal with another in order to create a null cancel out. <i>The establishment of a new interim government was declared <b>null</b> and void.</i>
<b><u>override</u></b>	Prevail over. <i>The House vote in favour of the bill was 10 votes short of the requisite majority for an <b>override</b>.</i>
<b>repeal</b>	The action of revoking or annulling a law or act of parliament. <i>The legislation was <b>repealed</b> five months later.</i>
<b>rescind</b>	Cancel officially. <i>The government eventually <b>rescinded</b> the directive.</i>
<b>reverse</b>	The gears by which the motion of a machine can be reversed. <i>Their press ads had a headline <b>reversed</b> out of the illustration.</i>
<b>reversible</b>	(of a reaction) occurring together with its converse, and so yielding an equilibrium mixture of reactants and products. <i>A <b>reversible</b> pushchair seat.</i>
<b>revocable</b>	Capable of being revoked or cancelled. <i>A <b>revocable</b> order.</i>
<b><u>revoke</u></b>	Cancel officially. <i>The men appealed and the sentence was <b>revoked</b>.</i>
<b>unoccupied</b>	(of a building, seat, etc.) not being occupied or used. <i><b>Unoccupied</b> areas of France.</i>
<b>vacancy</b>	Empty space. <i><b>Vacancy</b> vanity and inane deception.</i>
<b><u>vacant</u></b>	Without an occupant or incumbent. <i>40 per cent of the offices are still <b>vacant</b>.</i>
<b>vacuum</b>	Clean with a vacuum cleaner. <i>Without their support he ll be ruling in a <b>vacuum</b>.</i>
<b>vain</b>	Having or showing an excessively high opinion of one's appearance, abilities, or worth. <i>A <b>vain</b> attempt to tidy up the room.</i>
