- Deliberately destroy or damage (public or private property.
- Destroy wantonly, as through acts of vandalism.





Synonyms of "Vandalize" as a verb (15 Words)

<u>blemish</u>	Add a flaw or blemish to make imperfect or defective. <i>Her face was blemished.</i>
<u>blight</u>	Infect plants with blight. Some people complain that wind farms blight the landscape.
<u>deface</u>	Mar or spoil the appearance of. Scars deface d her cheeks.
<u>defile</u>	Damage the purity or appearance of; mar or spoil. The townspeople defile d the river by emptying raw sewage into it.
<u>desecrate</u>	Treat (a sacred place or thing) with violent disrespect. Many lanes are desecrate d with yellow lines.
disfigure	Mar or spoil the appearance of. <i>Litter disfigures the countryside</i> .
do damage to	Carry out or perform an action.



<u>harm</u>	Cause or do harm to. These pills won t harm your system.
<u>impair</u>	Make worse or less effective. A noisy job could permanently impair their hearing.
injure	Suffer physical harm or damage to (a part of one's body. A libel calculated to injure the company s reputation.
mangle	Press with a mangle. <i>Mangle</i> the sheets.
mar	Make imperfect. Violence mar red a number of New Year celebrations.
mutilate	Inflict serious damage on. Most of the prisoners had been mutilate d.
spoil	(of food) become unfit for eating. The enemy entered into Hereford spoil ed and fired the city and razed the walls to the ground.
vandalico	Destroy wantonly, as through acts of yandalism

vandalise Destroy wantonly, as through acts of vandalism.
