Associations of "Vase" (30 Words)

bottle	Store liquids or gases in bottles. <i>Bottle the mineral water.</i>
bowl	The contents of a bowl. <i>Hey you wanna smoke a bowl with us.</i>
ceramic	The art of making ceramic articles. <i>A ceramic designer.</i>
chalice	The wine cup used in the Christian Eucharist.
china	Household tableware or other objects made from china or a similar material. <i>A plate made of china.</i>
chinaware	Dishware made of high quality porcelain.
crockery	Plates, dishes, cups, and other similar items, especially ones made of earthenware or china.
<u>cup</u>	Any cup shaped concavity. <i>A cup of butter.</i>
earthen	Relating to or characteristic of the earth or material existence. <i>Earthen mounds.</i>
earthenware	Pottery made of clay fired to a porous state which can be made impervious to liquids by the use of a glaze. <i>An earthenware jug.</i>
ewer	An open vessel with a handle and a spout for pouring.
figurine	A statuette, especially one of a human form.
goblet	A drinking glass with a foot and a stem. <i>A beautifully engraved crystal goblet.</i>
gourd	A climbing or trailing plant which bears gourds.
jar	The quantity contained in a jar. <i>A jar of coffee.</i>

<u>mug</u>	The quantity that can be held in a mug. <i>He was mugged by three men who stole his bike.</i>
pitcher	The contents of a pitcher. <i>A pitcher of water.</i>
<u>plate</u>	The quantity contained in a plate. <i>She lifted the plate in victory.</i>
porcelain	Porcelain articles collectively. <i>The paintings porcelains and prints that go on the block.</i>
pottery	A factory or workshop where pottery is made. <i>A visit to a Staffordshire pottery.</i>
pumpkin	The plant of the gourd family that produces pumpkins having tendrils and large lobed leaves and native to warm regions of America. <i>Listen pumpkin I thought you ought to know.</i>
<u>relic</u>	An antiquity that has survived from the distant past. <i>Miracles wrought by the relics of St Stephen.</i>
silverware	Tableware made of silver or silver plate or pewter or stainless steel.
spout	Express (one's views or ideas) in a lengthy, declamatory, and unreflecting way. <i>Blood was spouting from the cuts on my hand.</i>
statuette	A small carved or molded figure.
tableware	Crockery, cutlery, and glassware used for serving and eating meals at a table.
urn	Place in an urn. <i>A weathered stone urn.</i>
utensil	An implement for practical use (especially in a household). <i>Kitchen utensils.</i>
vitrify	Convert (something) into glass or a glasslike substance, typically by exposure to heat. <i>The option of vitrifying nuclear waste presents problems.</i>
