## Associations of "Vase" (30 Words)

<b>bottle</b>	Store liquids or gases in bottles. <i><b>Bottle</b> the mineral water.</i>
<b>bowl</b>	The contents of a bowl. <i>Hey you wanna smoke a <b>bowl</b> with us.</i>
<b>ceramic</b>	The art of making ceramic articles. <i>A <b>ceramic</b> designer.</i>
<b>chalice</b>	The wine cup used in the Christian Eucharist.
<b>china</b>	Household tableware or other objects made from china or a similar material. <i>A plate made of <b>china</b>.</i>
<b>chinaware</b>	Dishware made of high quality porcelain.
<b>crockery</b>	Plates, dishes, cups, and other similar items, especially ones made of earthenware or china.
<a href="#"><u>cup</u></a>	Any cup shaped concavity. <i>A <b>cup</b> of butter.</i>
<b>earthen</b>	Relating to or characteristic of the earth or material existence. <i><b>Earthen</b> mounds.</i>
<b>earthenware</b>	Pottery made of clay fired to a porous state which can be made impervious to liquids by the use of a glaze. <i>An <b>earthenware</b> jug.</i>
<b>ewer</b>	An open vessel with a handle and a spout for pouring.
<b>figurine</b>	A statuette, especially one of a human form.
<b>goblet</b>	A drinking glass with a foot and a stem. <i>A beautifully engraved crystal <b>goblet</b>.</i>
<b>gourd</b>	A climbing or trailing plant which bears gourds.
<b>jar</b>	The quantity contained in a jar. <i>A <b>jar</b> of coffee.</i>

<b><u>mug</u></b>	The quantity that can be held in a mug. <i>He was <b>mugged</b> by three men who stole his bike.</i>
<b>pitcher</b>	The contents of a pitcher. <i>A <b>pitcher</b> of water.</i>
<b><u>plate</u></b>	The quantity contained in a plate. <i>She lifted the <b>plate</b> in victory.</i>
<b>porcelain</b>	Porcelain articles collectively. <i>The paintings <b>porcelains</b> and prints that go on the block.</i>
<b>pottery</b>	A factory or workshop where pottery is made. <i>A visit to a Staffordshire <b>pottery</b>.</i>
<b>pumpkin</b>	The plant of the gourd family that produces pumpkins having tendrils and large lobed leaves and native to warm regions of America. <i>Listen <b>pumpkin</b> I thought you ought to know.</i>
<b><u>relic</u></b>	An antiquity that has survived from the distant past. <i>Miracles wrought by the <b>relics</b> of St Stephen.</i>
<b>silverware</b>	Tableware made of silver or silver plate or pewter or stainless steel.
<b>spout</b>	Express (one's views or ideas) in a lengthy, declamatory, and unreflecting way. <i>Blood was <b>spouting</b> from the cuts on my hand.</i>
<b>statuette</b>	A small carved or molded figure.
<b>tableware</b>	Crockery, cutlery, and glassware used for serving and eating meals at a table.
<b>urn</b>	Place in an urn. <i>A weathered stone <b>urn</b>.</i>
<b>utensil</b>	An implement for practical use (especially in a household). <i>Kitchen <b>utensils</b>.</i>
<b>vitrify</b>	Convert (something) into glass or a glasslike substance, typically by exposure to heat. <i>The option of <b>vitrifying</b> nuclear waste presents problems.</i>
